

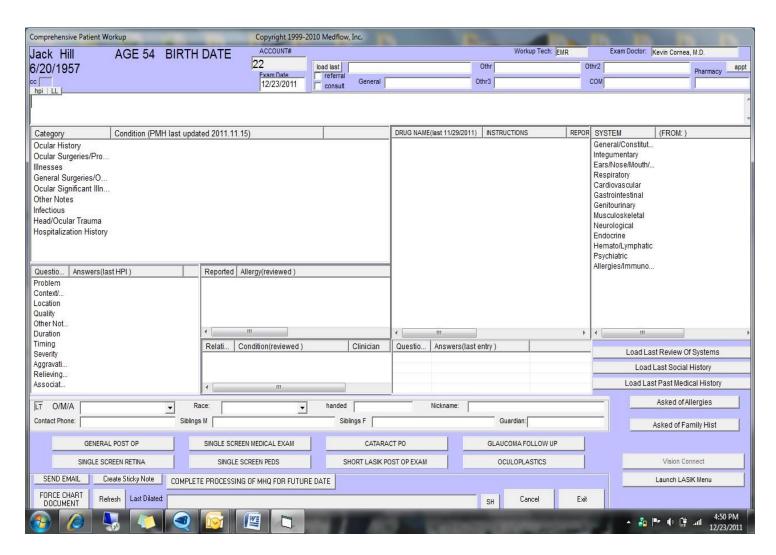
Cataract Post Op Screen

Cataract Post Op Specialty Exam Screen

Summary: The Cataract Post Op Exam Screen is used to document any unilateral post op cataract visit.

Accessing the Cataract Post Op Specialty Exam Screen: The Cataract Post Op Exam Screen can be accessed in two different ways.

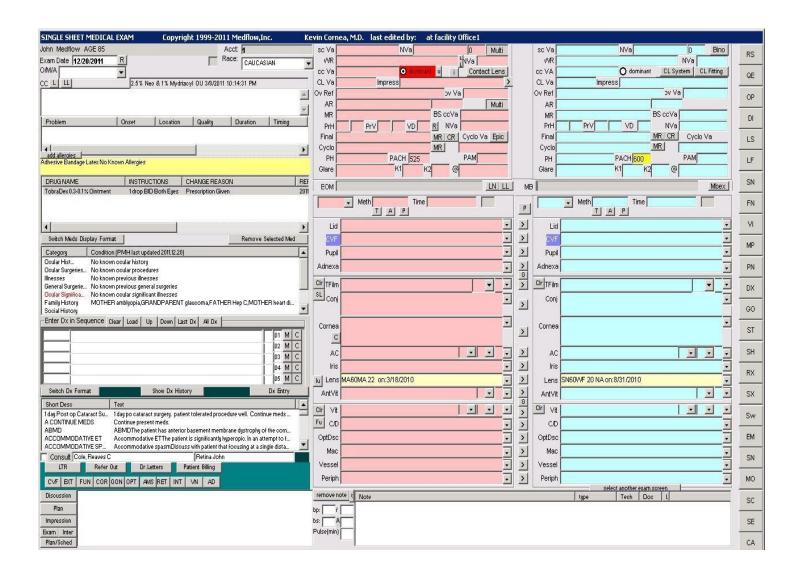
- 1. From the Specialized Exam Screen:
- a. Choose Cataract PO button at bottom of screen.







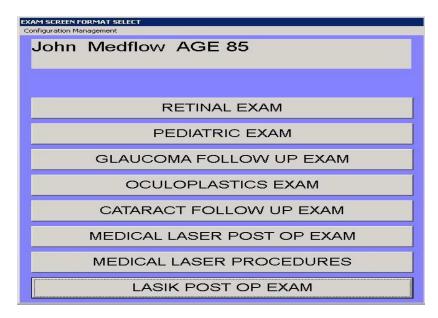
- 2. From within another exam screen:
- a. Choose the button at the bottom of the left eye: select another exam screen.



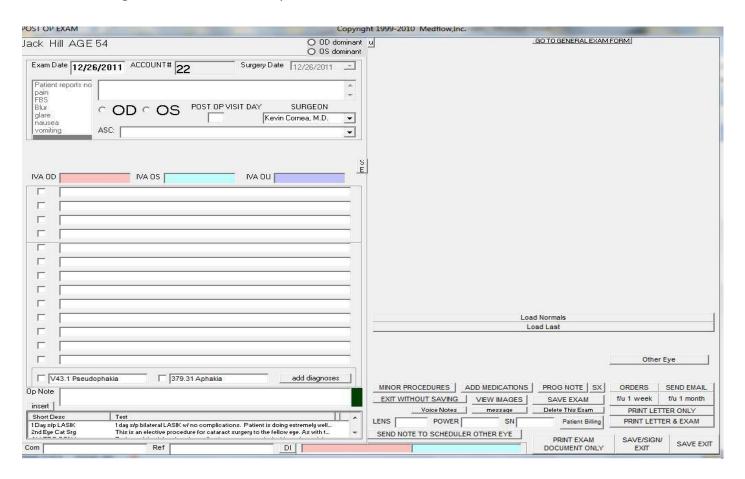
This will take you to the following screen to select: CATARACT FOLLOW UP EXAM







When entering the Cataract Post Op Screen, the screen will be inactive.

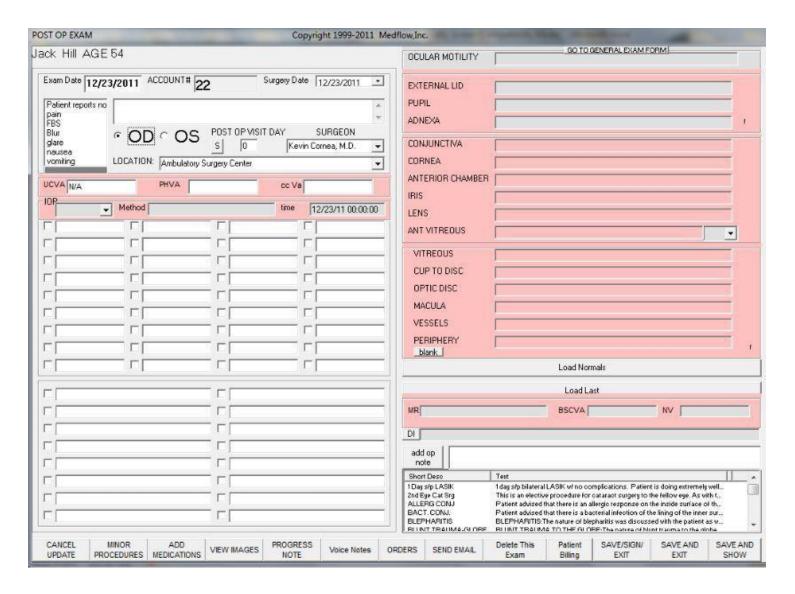






To activate the screen you must choose the correct surgeon, the correct surgery location and the correct eye in that order.

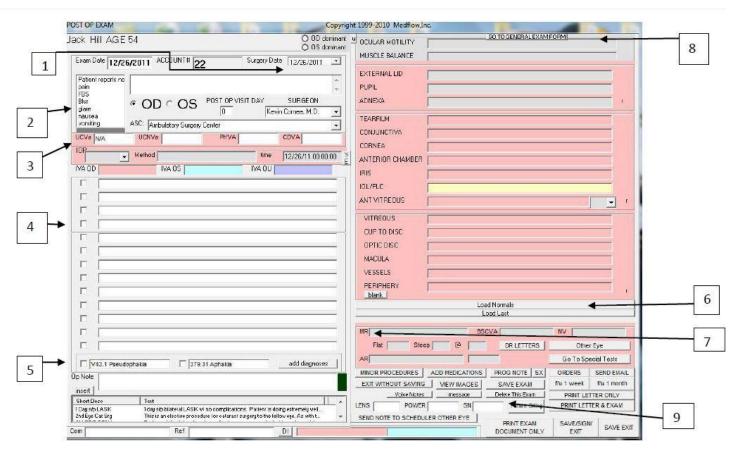
The screen will then activate.







The screen below has been labeled as to the functions in the Cataract Post Op Exam Screen.



- 1) The surgery date should be completed using the drop down arrow. Choose the date from the calendar.
- 2) The reason for the visit/chief complaint can be populated with a single click.
- 3) Vision can be populated from a choice list with a double click on UCVA, PHVA, or ccVA.
- 4) These choice boxes can be customized per doctor with medication instructions.
- Special Note User should still manage medications using ADD MEDICATIONS button.
- 5) These choice boxes can be customized per doctor with follow up/post op instructions that the doctor gives to patients.
- 6) Click on LOAD NORMALS to load previously customized exam defaults.
- 7) Manifest can be populated by double clicking on MR.
- 8) To move to the single screen exam single click on GO TO GENERAL EXAM FORM.
- 9) The LENS, POWER and SN (serial number) boxes will fill with information from ACPT (Advanced Cataract Planning Tool)

The gray buttons across the bottom of the screen will take you to different areas of the exam.
