

## Menu Measure #4: Family Health History

Attestation threshold: More than 20 percent of all unique patients seen by the EP during the EHR reporting period have a structured data entry for one or more first-degree relatives.

Family Health History is structured with Family codes and Condition codes that are hard coded. The system will only allow you to select from the list of Conditions as well as First Degree Family History and/or Other Family History.

Choices for **Family Members** include the following:



**Note:** The First Degree Family History section **WILL** qualify for MU. Other Family History section does **NOT** qualify for MU.

1. Double click in the Family History section to open the screen




- 2. Select the **Condition** of the Family member
- 3. Select the radio button for the Family member associated with the Condition All entries will populate under Condition with a Family Code and Condition linked
- 4. All entries will populate under Condition with a Family Code and Condition linked

**Note:** The **No Significant Family History** and **Family History Unknown** will automatically generate the entry when the user checks the box. Un-check the box to make any other selections to the list after the entry is generated. If not un-checked the other areas of the screen will be inaccessible.



To remove information from an entry error OR to remove historical entries not codified:

- Highlight the Condition and then select Remove Highlighted Item
- Select the **Esc** key on your keyboard or the **Exit** button when complete



Note: To receive Meaningful Use credit you will need to remove historical data that is not codified and reenter as structured data with the updated V8.1.
